If so, this may not be the volunteer role for you but keep reading, just in case, because you might surprise yourself!

Village Hall Players is looking for 3 – 4 people to work backstage on our upcoming production, *No Way to Treat a Lady*. As a not-for-profit community group, VHP is unable to pay anyone, which is why we are seeking volunteers.

Stagehands are needed to open and close curtains (we have three different curtains at the KMI Hall), place sets and props on stage in the correct location and bring them off on cue.

You'll be committing to a three-month period of around 5 hours per week during rehearsals, and slightly longer hours during final dress/tech rehearsals and on performance dates.

The main requirements for these roles are reliability, the ability to lift and carry, a willingness to learn, and a sense of humour! Oh, and a Working with Children Check is also required as we have some young people crewing for us. Volunteer checks are free.

You'll also need an all-black outfit: long-sleeved top, long pants, socks and shoes.

Why you should give it a try: you get to see live theatre from a whole new perspective; you'll be learning skills that could help you with employment; and we have lots of fun, including a cast and crew party at the end of the season.
