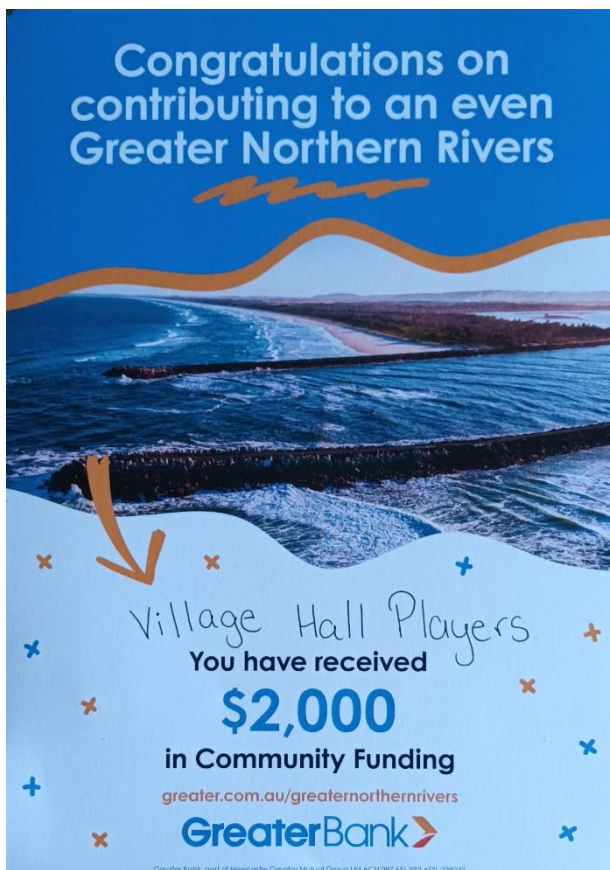

Thank you to everyone who voted for us. We are incredibly grateful for your support.

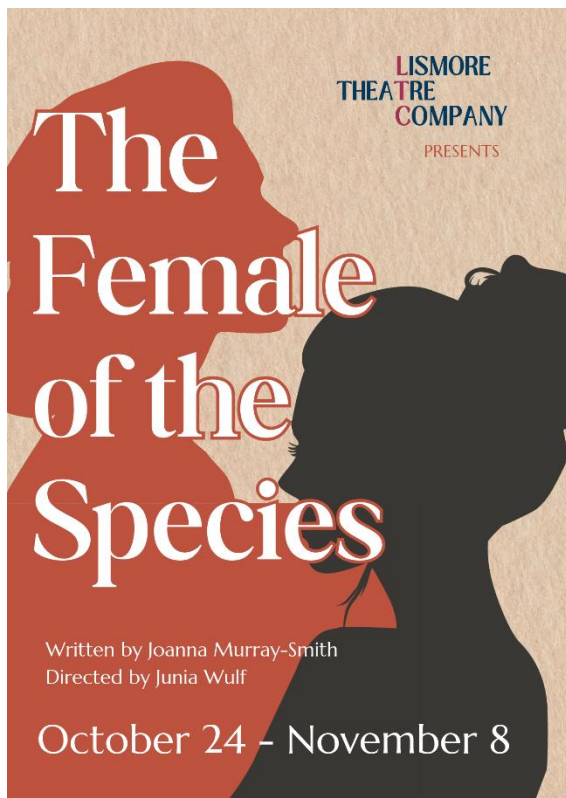
On Wednesday 24th October, two wonderful Greater Bank employees came to the KMI and presented us with one of those big, fake cheques (see photo next page).
